The true love of God: It is an error to imagine that the love of God is merely effective, a certain delight or joy we experience in God. It is rather an act of the understanding and of the will. Man recognizes God to be the supreme Good, and esteems Him above all creatures. This esteem causes him to strive to attain to the possession of the sovereign Good, by avoiding sin and leading a godly life. The love of God shows itself more by deeds than in feelings. The love of God is called a holy or supernatural love. It is to be distinguished from a purely natural affection, such as that of a parent for his child, as well as from a sensual affection, which chiefly regards the body.
