**Tues., Jan. 5, The Vigil of the Epiphany of the Lord, the traditional making of Epiphany Water** will take place, preceded by First Vespers of Epiphany at 5:30 pm. This water is used to bless homes during the Octave of the Epiphany. All are welcome to this once in a year event, especially those who chant the office! Handouts will be provided.

**Wed., January 6 is the Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord.** Although not a holy day of obligation, to encourage attendance at this ancient and venerable feast of the Church, there will be the normal 8:00 am mass and a 10:00 am sung mass that day. Also, the traditional home Epiphany Blessing will be offered to homes requesting it through the former octave (Jan. 6 through Jan. 13). Otherwise, when available, you may take Epiphany water, blessed chalk, and a ceremony pamphlet (all to be made available at the back of church Wednesday evening) and apply this sacramental to your home.

**Next Sunday, Jan. 10, there will be an Ask Father** in the basement during the latter part of the brunch.
