ON THE GOSPEL

Thy faith hath made thee whole.

I do not go looking for someone possessed by a spirit, nor seek advice through sacrilegious divinations; nor do I go to the worship of demons. And neither do I serve idols. But I am a Donatist." What does it avail you to offend your Father, since He will punish your offences against your Mother?
