ON THE GOSPEL

Seek ye first the Kingdom of God...

That He uses the word *first*, signifies that this (*the Kingdom of God*) is to be looked for later; that it is first, not in time, but in importance: the one is our true *good*; the rest are needed that we may attain to this. For example: we should not preach the Gospel that we may eat; for then we would hold the Gospel as less than food; but we eat that we may preach the Gospel. But if we who *seek first* the kingdom of God and His justice, that is, place this above all other things, so that we seek other things because of it, we should have no anxiety lest what we need will be wanting to us; and accordingly He says: *all these things shall be added unto you*: that is, suitably and so that they shall be no hindrance to you: so that while you seek them, you shall not be turned aside from the other end; nor set two ends before you (as by way of serving two masters.) ~ St. Augustine, Bishop, Doctor; 430 †.
