From the Diocese:

Fr. Steve Biegler Elected Diocesan Administrator

According to Canon Law, when a diocesan bishop is transferred to another diocese, a priest from the diocese is elected to be the Diocesan Administrator. The election is held by the College of Consultors, a group of priests whom the bishop consults regularly for advice. The administrator then governs the diocese until a new bishop is named. For example, he has faculties to administer Confirmation and may delegate other priests to administer Confirmation. The Consultors have elected Fr. Steve Biegler as our Diocesan Administrator. A native of Timber Lake and ordained in 1993, he has served the parishes of Cathedral, Bonesteel/Fairfax, and McLaughlin and its missions. This July, Bishop Cupich appointed Fr. Steve to oversee the *Terra Sancta* project. He will continue in that role while serving as Diocesan Administrator and will continue to serve as the priest for St. Michael's in Hermosa and as chaplain for the SDSM&T Newman Center. Please pray for Fr. Steve and ask God to bless our diocese with a new bishop who is filled with the Holy Spirit.
