## ON THE GOSPEL

*Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself.*

The second commandment is like the first, since it commands the love of man, made in the image of God, and perhaps also in His likeness. In the exposition of the command to love of neighbor, these things must also be learned. Since in accord with what is said in the tenth psalm, *He that love iniquity, hates his own soul*, and in accord with what is said in Proverbs, *He that rejects instruction, despises his own soul*, it is evident, that no one who loves iniquity loves his neighbor as himself, since neither does he love himself; and that no one who rejects instruction, loves his neighbor as himself, since he does not even love his own self. And so it comes about that he who *loves iniquity*, both hates his own soul, and is unable to fulfill the second commandment. And in the same way whoever rejects instruction loves sin: and so he who rejects any word of the teaching of God, hates his own soul.
